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## **Connecticut Insurance Department Fines CNA Insurance Group \$96,000**

### *Company Practices Not in Compliance with Connecticut Law*

*Hartford* — Connecticut Insurance Commissioner Thomas R. Sullivan signed orders yesterday fining subsidiaries of CNA Insurance Group, headquartered in Illinois, \$96,000 for violations of state law.

The total fine results from smaller fines assessed to subsidiary companies for alleged violations to Connecticut state laws related to licensing/appointments of agents, loss of use, and inadequate notice of renewal for commercial lines.

Violations and fines varied by company.

Transportation Insurance Company, Illinois	\$11,000
Transcontinental Insurance Company, Massachusetts	\$29,000
Valley Forge Insurance Company, Pennsylvania	\$44,000
American Casualty Company of Reading, Pennsylvania	\$12,000

The company complied with the stipulations and final orders, and will submit a compliance report to the commissioner within 90 days.
