### WORKERS' COMPENSATION FILING AND HEARING ANNOUNCED

Notice is hereby given that the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Connecticut by his designated hearing officer will conduct a public hearing on Monday, October 27 at 10:00 o'clock a.m. in Room 701 at the Insurance Department, 7th floor, 153 Market Street, Hartford, to consider a workers' compensation filing submitted by the National Council on Compensation Insurance (NCCI). NCCI's filing for voluntary market advisory pure premium loss costs and assigned risk plan rates are proposed to be effective January 1, 2009. NCCI proposes an average decrease of 1.4% for pure premium loss costs and an average increase of 1.6% in assigned risk rates.

The overall change in the filing are distributed by major industry group as follows:

Industry Group	Pure Premium Loss Cost Change (%)	Assigned Risk Plan Rate Change (%)
Manufacturing	-4.6%	-1.7%
Contracting	-1.1%	+1.9%
Office & Clerical	-3.5%	-0.5%
Goods & Services	+2.3%	+5.5%
Miscellaneous	-4.5%	-1.5%
<b>Overall</b>	<b>-1.4%</b>	<b>+1.6%</b>
