

On April 26, 2007, Norwalk Power LLC submitted to the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission for approval an unexecuted Cost of Service Agreement between itself, NRG Power Marketing, Inc. and ISO-New England governing the provision of Reliability Must Run service by Norwalk Harbor Station Unit 1 and 2. Norwalk Harbor is authorized to submit Peaking Unit Safe Harbor (PUSH) bids for Norwalk Harbor Units 1 and 2 however in January 2007, the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission accepted modifications to the market rules that will eliminate PUSH bidding effective June 19, 2007. As a result, Norwalk Power LLC is seeking authorization from the FERC to operate pursuant to an RMR Agreement effective June 19, 2007. If approved, the agreement will terminate in June 2010. The docket number for this filing is ER07-799-000.
