

Donations to the Department of Veterans' Affairs

As an agency of the State of Connecticut, donations of cash or goods are tax deductible to the donor under IRS Code Section 170-1. For federal tax purposes, the donor is responsible for estimating and defending the value of the items donated.

All cash donations are accepted into the Business Office. Donations must be presented by check made out to "The Department of Veterans' Affairs" with a notation on the check specifying a designation for the contribution, such as "General Welfare of Veterans" or "For End of Life Care for Veteran Patients" or "In Memory of _____".
