- i. Chairman Valleries would like the Regulations reviewed. He shared concern re: the PV1 & 2 License requirement, that states One year experience required. The Chairman felt that One year was not adequate, and he would like the Regulations changed to at least 2 years required. Richard state the Jack Guerrea said he will not host the PV apprenticeship program. **Board Member Reid motioned that the PV1 & PV2 requirements should be changed to “The requirements to qualify for this license exam shall be the completion of a registered apprenticeship program or at least two (2) years of equivalent experience and training”. Board Member Muthersbaugh 2nd, and the vote carried unanimously.**

The Board would like the language in the SP1/SP2 reviewed. There was concern regarding the word “**Modify**” it’s broad and can be misconstrued. The board would like to see the word “Modify” clarified and/or define.
