Legal Division-

Attorney Schwane provided an update to some proposed legislation.

Public Act- 11-117 Section 5 - allows licensees to apply for a retiree status. The Board of Examiners for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors has had this retiree status in their Rules & Regulations.

At the June 14, 2011 meeting, Chairman D'Andrea inquired if computer based testing (CBT) that will be implemented in 2014, goes against the Board's Rules & Regulations. Attorney Schwane reported to the Board that he researched the statutes and regulations to find the definition of written. Since there was no definition found, the general definition can be used where computer is another way of writing. CBT testing does not go against the statutes or rules & regulations, therefore no regulatory changes are required.
