



## Test Procedures

### General Information

- To be admitted to the exam you must bring your acceptance letter and a photo ID (i.e.: Driver's License).
- The exams are comprised of Multiple-Choice, True/False, Open-Ended and Essay questions. See chart below for details.
- Fire Safety Code Inspector and Hazardous Materials Inspector Exams are open-book. Acceptable reference materials are listed on the back of this sheet.
- All other examinations are closed-book.
- You will be tested only on material pertinent to the license you are seeking.
- Laptop computers, palm pilots, etc. are not permitted.
- Cell phones must be turned off and put away.
- There will be no scheduled breaks.
- Bottled water is allowed, food is not.
- You must earn a minimum overall score of 70% to pass the written exam.

- Calculator (non-graphical calculator for all crane exams, calculator optional for other tests)
- #2 pencils (bring two)
- Acceptable Reference Materials (Hazmat and Fire Safety Code Only – see **Study References** for details)
