Special Considerations:	The Work of the General Contractor shall be performed by a "Specialist" or "Specialty Contractor," who is an individual or firm, acting as the General Contractor or as a Subcontractor, of established reputation for performance of work of highest quality, or if newly organized, whose personnel have previously established a similar reputation in the same field, which is regularly engaged in, and which maintains a regular force of workmen skilled in either manufacturing or fabricating items required by the Contract, installing items required by the Contract. The "Specialist" must demonstrate previous work on at least five buildings listed on the national register of Historic Places. Firms that do not meet these criteria will not be considered as qualified, in the sole judgment of the Owner.

Prevailing Wage Rates: Prevailing wages are required on this project, in accordance with the schedule provided in the bid documents, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes Section 31-53 (a-h), as amended.

Each contractor who is awarded a contract on or after October 1, 2002 shall be subject to provisions of the Connecticut General Statutes, Section 31-53 as amended by Public Act 02-69, "An Act Concerning Annual Adjustments to Prevailing Wages."

Wage Rates will be posted each July 1st on the Department of Labor website: www.ctdol.state.ct.us . Such prevailing wage adjustment shall not be considered a matter for any contract amendment.
