The subcommittee voted to approve the minutes of the January 13, 2010 meeting. George Iskra abstained.

The subcommittee voted to accept AIA-CT's submission of comments in response to the proposed code changes. George Iskra abstained.

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Under communications, the meeting agenda contained one code change proposal and three items of correspondence. The chair noted that the code change proposal submitted by Donald Mitchell regarding radon control will be deferred until the next code cycle. The items of correspondence all pertain to the proposed code changes submitted by the Connecticut Fund for the Environment/Environment Northeast.

Charles Rothenberger and James Howland presented 21 proposed code changes (attached) that they submitted to the subcommittee at the end of December. The subcommittee will act on these proposals at the next meeting. Items 2 and 3, which deal with toilets and lavatory fixtures, will be discussed with the review of the 2009 editions of the International Plumbing Code and International Residential Code, rather than being made part of the amendment to the 2005 State Building Code that is currently under development.

Note: Item # 4 of the submission contains an incorrect code citation. The correct citation is section 103.1.
