The subcommittee voted to accept the following minutes of the meeting: April 22, 2009, May 13, 2009 and May 22, 2009.

Chairman Louis Free discussed the changes that must be made to the State Building Code to comply with legislative mandates. The initial code revision review shall focus on the adoption of the 2009 ICC International Energy Conservation Code® (IECC) to the 2005 Connecticut State Building Code in accordance with Public Act 09-192. The second code revision review shall focus on the adoption the 2009 Family of ICC Codes and NFPA 101 for existing buildings (2011/2012 Connecticut State Building Code) comprised of the following:

- 2009 ICC International Building Code® (IBC)
- 2009 ICC International Residential Code® (IRC)
- 2009 ICC International Mechanical Code® (IMC)
- 2009 ICC International Plumbing Code® (IPC)
- 2009 ICC International Fire Code® (IFC)
- 2009 ICC International Energy Conservation Code® (IECC)
- 2009 ICC International Existing Building Code® (IEBC)
- 2008 National Electrical Code (NFPA 71)
- 2009 NFPA Life Safety Code® (NFPA 101)
