The subcommittee reviewed the final draft position statement regarding Sustainable Design Requirements. Following certain editorial changes, the subcommittee voted to accept the position statement. The statement recommends adoption of the *2009 International Energy Conservation Code (IECC)*, which references ANSI/ASHRAE/IESNA Standard 90.1-2007, *Energy Standard for Buildings except Low-Rise Residential Buildings*. The approved position statement shall be forwarded as soon as possible to all members of the Codes and Standards Committee with notation that a vote to accept will be on the agenda for the June 10, 2009 meeting of the Codes and Standards Committee.

Following the Codes and Standards Committee vote, the position statement shall be submitted to the Director of the Division of Fire, Emergency & Building Services for transmittal to the Commissioner of Public Safety (the Commissioner

will further disseminate as he deems appropriate). Acting together with the Office of State Building Inspector, the next step for the Codes and Standards Committee will be to draft the amendment to the 2005 State Building Code that will incorporate this recommendation. The chair asked that Office of State Building Inspector staff begin a review to identify how the 2009 IECC differs from the 2006 edition.
