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Mr. Koestner is a Board Certified Behavior Analyst (BCBA) and a certified special education teacher. He has a Master's degree in Special Education with a concentration in Autism. Mr. Koestner has worked with individuals with autism and intellectual disabilities for almost 7 years in both the school and home settings; to support the individual, families, and school staff.

Mr. Koestner worked as a special education teacher for 4 years before becoming a BCBA. As a special education teacher, Mr. Koestner taught students with autism in a self-contained classroom; focusing on academics,, daily life skills, socials skills, and increasing appropriate behaviors. As a BCBA, Mr. Koestner works in school districts and homes to develop behavior intervention plans, conduct ongoing training for families and staff, and work with the individuals to model the behavior intervention plan for families and staff. Mr. Koestner also conducts social groups for individuals with high functioning autism.

To increase skill sets and socially appropriate behaviors, Mr. Koestner develops behavior intervention plans specifically targeting the skills to increase; while monitoring the implementation of the behavior intervention plans by staff and families. Mr. Koestner utilizes data collection methods to determine the effectiveness of the behavior intervention plans; modifying plans when necessary. Mr. Koestner is experienced with conducting functional Behavior Assessments, Functional Analysis, and Ecological Assessments.
