RMS initially began providing services in 1982; partnering with local ARCs to ensure the availability of community residential opportunities for individuals living with intellectual disabilities. Over the past 30 years, RMS has grown and diversified as a service provider; supporting 200 individuals who live in CLAs or their own homes or apartments, and additionally providing some day supports to people. RMS serves people with a wide range of strengths, preferences and support needs and integrates a philosophy of individualization and person centeredness within its service approach. The staff at RMS work hard to create environments that are positive, friendly, nurturing and supportive to people living a life of their choosing. People who are supported have a voice in the agency and there are self-advocacy meetings for people to share their viewpoint and create a stronger collective voice. RMS is very committed to the people who receive supports and works to adjust supports based on the changing needs and preferences of those served. RMS has the capability to provide continued services to people as they age and need increased health support. RMS is faithful to its core values which include: respect, the development of meaningful relationships, expanded life and learning opportunities across the life span.
