Information provided by the provider describing their agency:

United Cerebral Palsy – We are more than our name. We support individuals with ALL DISABILITIES and offer the following programs and services:

Adult Group Day- Old Saybrook and Quaker Hill. Cheerful, modern settings offering opportunities for volunteer work, community outings, socialization and recreation. Able to support individuals with complex medical and physical disabilities.

Extended Day and after school for teens and young adults.

Individual Day – Programs tailored to individual needs. Support individuals in their social, work, leisure and community-based needs in order to develop and/or maintain independence.

In Home Supports – Person centered supports provided in-home to those who live independently. Supports include med admin, employment, finances, cleaning, meal planning and prep, recreation, transportation, and social. We also offer a cluster setting which allows for impromptu supports from staff and social opportunities within the integrated apartment community. Individuals rent their own apartment, with overnight supports available. Assistance with daily living activities occurs on a schedule but intermittently,



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thus allowing the individual to experience independent living to their fullest ability.

Supported Employment – Assist individuals in getting paid employment and provide coaching to maintain and support ongoing employment.

Healthcare Coordination – For those individuals who qualify, our nurse will provide assessment, education and assistance to support to their complex health conditions and ensure their safety and wellbeing.
