Cynthia – It is our understanding that the clean-up is being regulated under the transfer act and the DEEP has delegated to a Licensed Environmental Professional (LEP) who has provided Remedial Action Planning documents demonstrating that the site will be cleaned up in accordance with Remediation Standard Regulations (Section 22a-133k). The previous RAP amendment that I sent you yesterday, dated 9/19/12, does indicate the remedial activities are proposed to meet the objectives of the Remediation Standard Regulations.

If needed, I can provide the previous RAP's which show the actual documentation that the project is subject to these regulations. These documents are also referenced in the RAP amendment dated 9/19/12.
