



Summary: There are three core sites in Rocky Hill which contain rock from the East Berlin Formation (Jeb). One core was drilled at Dinosaur State Park (DSP); it intersects the third lake cycle below the Hampden Basalt (Olsen, 2003).

12 cores were drilled at Veterans Home, 5 feet of core was recovered from each site.

14 cores were drilled at the Public Health Laboratory, 5 to 20 feet of core was recovered from each site.

Three lake cycles can be observed in the Veterans and Public Health core sites. Correlation of the lake cycles with the standard section is uncertain at this time.
