Re: Final Infrastructure Upgrade Eligibility Memoranda

The Department of Energy and Environmental Protection's (DEEP) Municipal Water Pollution Control Section has completed its update of Clean Water Fund funding eligibility memoranda for roadway restoration and utility restoration:

1. Roadway Restoration Grant/Loan Eligibility

This memorandum delineates eligibility for restoration work required within roadways and other right-of-ways.

2. Utility Relocation Reimbursement

This memorandum reaffirms existing policy, and restates the reimbursement formula previously determined by the courts to be the appropriate formula for establishing the 'equitable share' for reimbursement to the utility company by a municipality.

On March 8, 2013, draft versions of these memoranda were provided for public comment via email and/or regular mail, as well as on our website. After review and consideration of the comments received, the memoranda were revised and finalized.

Both memoranda shall apply to eligibility determinations on a forward looking basis.
