Pursuant to section 4-168(d) of the Connecticut General Statutes, the Department hereby gives notice of its intent to proceed with the adoption of proposed regulations regarding the collection, transportation, reuse, refurbishment and recycling of covered electronic devices ("CEDs").

The proposed regulations were the subject of a public hearing held on October 26, 2009.
