Dear Mr. Cutler:

The Connecticut Department of Environmental Protection’s (CT DEP) Site Assessment and Support Unit (SASU) is issuing a RFP that outlines services and resources to facilitate the closure and cleanup of federally regulated underground storage tank sites. In the Recovery Act, Congress appropriated \$200 million to EPA for cleaning up petroleum leaks and of that amount, CT DEP expects to receive 2 million within the next few months. Cleanup will commence at sites that meet LUST cleanup eligibility requirements and work will have to commence as quickly as possible. Your company is presently under consideration because it is eligible to perform Hazardous Site Remediation Services for the CT DEP under the DAS contract award no. 05PSX0271.

The sites that the LUST Recovery Act will target are those that pose the greatest threat to human health and the environment and are thought to be shovel-ready projects. These are typically orphan or abandoned sites, where the owners/operators of the sites are unknown or unable to come into compliance with the CT DEPs underground storage tank regulations. Please see the RFP attachment which details the specifics about what CT DEP is seeking for deliverables and the response deadline of **August 14, 2009**.
