The following facts are known about this man:

Hispanic male, approx. 20-30 years old

Dark brown/black (spiked) hair

- * M R & Company dark blue-colored jeans
- * Timberland black colored belt with a silver buckle
- * J-CREW blue-and-white striped, button-down shirt, size 16-16-1/2
- * Victoria Brand grayish/blue hooded sweatshirt jacket, zipper in front, XXL
- * Nike Air -running shoes, size-11, gray and blue in color
- * White colored, ankle height socks
- * Tarra'O red-colored boxer briefs
- * Possibly wearing brown-colored rosary beads or wooden type necklace, brown in color, no cross attached
