Qualifications:

Candidates for Trooper Trainee appointments must:

- > Be at least 21 years of age by the expiration of the announced application period.
- > Be a U.S. citizen by the date of appointment.
- > Be in general good health and have sufficient strength, stamina and agility as required by the duties of the position.
- > Possess a high school diploma or GED by the completion of training.
- > Be free from felony and Class A and B misdemeanor convictions.
- > Have good educational and/or work record and excellent moral character.
- > Have normal hearing, normal color vision and depth perception.
- > Prior to academy graduation, candidates must obtain or retain a current, valid Connecticut Motor Vehicle Operator's License and establish residence in Connecticut.



The Selection Process

Begins with announcement of written exam via various sources of the media.

- > Interested candidates may then apply on-line at: www.das.state.ct.us

Early phases of the selection process include:

- > Written examination
- > Physical Fitness Assessment



Later phases (depending on how far you advance) include:

- > Polygraph examination
- > Background Investigation
- > Psychological evaluation
- > Medical Evaluation
- > Oral Interview

Successful completion of all phases of the selection process means that you are eligible to be considered for final appointment as a Trooper Trainee.



State Police Training Program:

If you are selected as a State Police Trooper Trainee, you will enter a six month training program at the State Police Academy. This program includes classroom instruction, practical exercises, and physical conditioning. After graduation from the program, Trooper Trainees are assigned to one of eleven State Police barracks throughout the State for a probationary period and on-the-job training.



When you graduate from the Connecticut State Police Academy you will have earned the title Connecticut State Trooper. This is a title that stays with you for life. Additionally, you will have completed one of the most intense law enforcement training programs in the nation. It is a goal many strive for but few achieve.
