Duties may include but not limited to: Provides comprehensive clinical assessments, risk assessments and medication management services to adults seen on an outpatient basis with severe and persistent mental illness and co-occurring substance use disorders. Functions as a co-leader of the treatment team and provides reviews of recovery plans, clinical records and discharge plans for adherence to policies and Joint Commission standards; provides all services in a recovery-oriented manner. Assesses, examines, diagnoses and prescribes appropriate medications and other biologic and psychosocial treatments to a caseload of about 150-200 adults, coordinates with primary and specialty care providers, as needed, and performs advanced level risk assessments; consults on difficult and/or complex cases. Additionally, this position may conduct comprehensive outpatient clinical intakes in conjunction with the intake department. This position will participate in on-call coverage and weekend coverage; performs related duties as required.

General Experience - Incumbents in this class must possess and retain certification as a specialist in psychiatry by the American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology or board certification in Adult or Child and Adolescent Psychiatry.

Special Requirements - Incumbents in this class must possess and retain a license to practice medicine and surgery in Connecticut. A temporary license may be granted for a period not to exceed one (1) year. Incumbents in this class must possess and maintain eligibility for participation in federal health care programs as defined in 42 U.S. 1320a-7b(f).

Note: The filling of this position will be in accordance with reemployment, SEBAC, transfer, promotion and merit employment rules, if applicable.

To be considered for this position:

1. **DMHAS employees who are lateral transfer candidates** (example: Principal Psychiatrist applying to a Principal Psychiatrist posting) must submit a completed DMHAS Lateral Transfer Form. Lateral Transfer Request Forms received without a position number will not be processed
2. **DMHAS employees who are promotional/demotional candidates** must submit the State of Connecticut Application for Examination and Employment (CT-HR-12). The position number must be noted at the bottom of Page One of the State of Connecticut Application (CT-HR-12).

All applicants must submit three (3) letters of supervisory reference, a copy of any license or certification and their two most recent performance appraisals.
