On August 3, 2015, the Commissioner of Agriculture, upon application of **Griffith Shellfish LLC, 61 Old Kings Highway South, Darien, CT** will lease to the highest responsible bidder, shellfish grounds in Greenwich formerly known as Lease 643A, a tract totaling 79.50 acres.

Beginning at a point being the southeast corner of lease 641 and the northeast corner of the piece herein described;

Thence South 12 Degrees 47 Minutes 28 Seconds East, a distance of 2315.29 feet to a point being the southeast corner of the piece herein described;

Bidder Acknowledges that it will not interfere with any established right of fishing. Pursuant to Conn. Gen. Stat. §26-204, the Connecticut Lobsterman's Association maintain an established right of fishing 12 months per year, which will be suspended for 3 months on 25% of the lease area on a rotating basis. Leases will be divided into quadrants which will be rotated quarterly.

By submitting a bid, bidder acknowledges that these grounds are leased to applicant solely for the purpose of planting, cultivating and harvesting shellfish. The bidder further acknowledges the bidder must have a valid Shellstock Shipper Harvest License within twenty (20) days of notification by the Department of Agriculture that a lease will be offered to the bidder and must maintain the license throughout the term of any lease. The bidder acknowledges that bidder may not use the leased lands for any purpose not herein specified, and bidder is the sole party in interest. A responsible bidder may not be in arrears to the state for taxes or upon debt or contract and may not be in default as surety, contractor, or otherwise on any obligation to the State. 
