## LEGAL NOTICE

On July 2, 2012, the Commissioner of Agriculture, upon the application of Brad Scher of Coastal Marine Fisheries 1 South Church Street, West Redding CT 06896, will lease to the highest responsible bidder, shellfish grounds in Greenwich totaling 59.15 acres as follows:

Beginning at a point being the Northeast corner of the lot herein described and having a latitude of 40 °-58.564' and a longitude of 73 °-32.296' ;

Thence along the easterly line of the lot herein described, South 34 Degrees 10 Minutes 17 Seconds West, a distance of 2575.04 feet to a point being the southeast corner of the lot herein described; having a latitude of 40 °-58.211' and a longitude of 73 °-32.606';

Thence along the southerly line of the lot herein described, North 56 Degrees 03 Minutes 39 Seconds West, a distance of 1003.54 feet to a point being the southwest corner of the lot herein described, having a latitude of 40 °-58.302' and a longitude of 73 °-32.788';
