*Description:*

The Continuing Recovery Skills Group is an intensive, evidenced based outpatient treatment module designed for individuals released from incarceration to community based supervision, on either Parole or Transitional Supervision status, who have at least 120 days remaining on their assigned release program. Using concepts and components of Hazelden's -Matrix Model,- it is designed to address the following key clinical areas: Myths about Alcohol, Relapse Prevention; Behavioral, Emotional and Physical Wellness; Employment and Financial Wellness; Personal and Intimate Relationships.
