List of Laboratories Approved to Analyze Radon in Water

Laboratories that analyze for radon in water must be approved by the Connecticut Department of Public Health (CT DPH) Environmental Laboratory Certification Program (per CGS §19a-29 and RCSA §19-4-1). The CT DPH recognizes and approves laboratories that use the liquid scintillation counting method for analysis of radon in water (i.e., Method 7500Rn B from *Standard Methods for the Examination of Water and Wastewater*, 20th ed., APHA-AWWA-WEF).

The following list includes the names of commercial laboratories currently approved by the CT DPH. Analysis of radon in water by a laboratory that is not approved by the CT DPH Environmental Laboratory Certification program is considered a statutory and regulatory violation.
