Flu Facts

DID YOU KNOW.....

- **Flu is a debilitating illness**
- **A person infected with influenza may be able to infect others before symptoms appear**
- **The flu virus is spread in respiratory droplets caused by coughing and sneezing**
- **The young, the elderly, and those with certain medical conditions such as asthma and diabetes are at high risk for complications of the flu**
- **Every year 5% to 20% of the population gets the flu**
- **Flu vaccinations can reduce absenteeism from flu related illnesses by approximately 45%**
- **Only 34% of 50 to 64 year olds get immunized**
- **More than 200,000 people are hospitalized every year from flu complications**
- **Annually about 36,000 people die from flu complications**
- **The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention states “the best way to prevent this illness is by getting a flu vaccination each fall” .**

Return On Investment

Flu Shots...The Key to A Healthy, Efficient, Productive Workplace

- **The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention reported that U.S. business could save up to \$12 billion annually by providing flu shots to employees**
- **Flu vaccinations can reduce absenteeism attributed to flu-related illness by approximately 45%**
- **The average number of days lost to influenza is 1.3 day**
- **The cost of treating flu-like illnesses including office visits, tests, procedures and medications is estimated at \$145.00 per case**
- **Vaccination can reduce physician visits**
- **Employers who value cost-effective ways to promote employee health offer workplace flu immunizations programs**
- **Providing flu vaccinations demonstrates to employees company concern for their health**
