

**Trends in the number of diagnosed HIV/AIDS cases, PLWHA, and deaths among HIV/AIDS cases, Connecticut, 2002-2009**



- The above slide shows the trend in the number of people living with HIV/AIDS from 2002 to 2008. It also shows the trend in the number of HIV/AIDS cases diagnosed and the number of deaths reported among persons with HIV/AIDS through 2007.
- The HIV/AIDS diagnosis year is the year in which the case was first diagnosed with HIV infection regardless of HIV or AIDS status. This data is affected by the lag in reporting (interval between diagnosis and report to DPH). For example, a case could be reported in 2008 that was diagnosed in 2008, 2007, or earlier. Data for 2008 is not shown for this reason. The year of diagnosis is established by the earliest confirmatory HIV test or earliest diagnosis date documented in the medical record.
- Deaths among persons with AIDS include deaths with HIV as an underlying cause of death as well as other causes. Previous Quickstat reports have additional death data.
