CONNECTICUT DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH REGULATORY ACTION REPORT QUARTER 3 2005

STATE REGULATIONS APPROVED

The following regulations were approved by the Legislative Regulation Review Committee:

Procedures for Creating and Indexing Confidential Adoption Records for Persons Born in this State –

To set forth the procedures for creating and indexing new birth certificates and confidential adoption records for adopted persons born in this state by the Department of Public Health and local registrars of vital records.

Effective: July 19, 2005

Amendments and Corrections to Vital Records - To comply with public act 01-163, which requires that the Department develop uniform methods and procedures for recording, preserving, indexing, and amending vital records.

Effective: August 1, 2005

Public Drinking Water Quality Standards - To amend Section 19-13-B102 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies in order to incorporate Federally mandated requirements pursuant to the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Section 40, Parts 9, 141 and 142, and the Federal Safe Drinking Water Act (SDWA) as amended. To maintain status as a Primary Enforcement State of the SDWA and relative Code of Federal Regulations.

Effective: August 1, 2005

Physician Reporting Form Change - To amend subsection (b) of section 19-13-D54 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies; to remove the requirement that a physician's name and address be reported to the Department of Public Health.

Effective: August 1, 2005

Traumatic Brain Injury Registry – To enact regulations as required by section 19a-6e of the Connecticut General Statutes to establish the criteria for a traumatic brain injury registry system; and to comply with section 19a-177 of the Connecticut General Statutes which requires periodic updates to the state trauma system.

Effective: September 6, 2005
