CONNECTICUT DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH REGULATORY ACTION REPORT 3rd QUARTER 2007

STATE REGULATIONS APPROVED

The following regulations were approved by the Legislative Regulation Review Committee:

Strike Contingency Plans for Health Care Facilities –

Statement of Purpose: (A) The purpose of the regulation is to make existing regulations consistent with Public Act No. 05-172; (B) the proposed regulation will allow the Department of Public Health to issue a civil penalty to a nursing home or residential care home that fails to submit a strike contingency plan in a specified time frame and/or submits a plan that does not provide for the health, safety and welfare of patients; (C) the proposed regulation will amend section 19a-497-a of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies.

Effective: July 3, 2007

Services Offered by Home Health Care Agencies –

(A) The purpose of the regulation is to make existing regulations consistent with Public Act 05-64. (B) The regulation will require a patient assessment by a home health care agency at least every sixty days by a registered nurse and that the assessment be performed while the homemaker-home health aide is providing services in the patient's home. (C) The regulation will amend subsection (a) of section 19-13-D69 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies.

Effective: July 3, 2007

Qualified Food Operator Testing Requirements –

Food Allergies – (A) The purpose of the regulation is to require that the test administered to qualified food operators include elements testing their knowledge of food allergies. (B) Existing DPH regulations require anyone who owns, operates, or manages a Class III or Class IV food service establishment to be a qualified food operator or employ on site at least one qualified food operator in a supervisory position. In order to be designated as such, a qualified food operator must pass a test administered by a DPH-approved testing organization that addresses the individual's knowledge of safe food handling techniques. (C) The proposed regulation will amend sections 19-13-B42, section 19-13-B48 and section 19-13-B49 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies pursuant to Public Act 05-122.

Effective: July 3, 2007

Civil Penalty Violations for Chronic & Convalescent Nursing Homes & Rest Homes with Nursing Supervision –

(A) The purpose of the regulations is to

update civil penalty cites to reflect changes in statutory requirements. (B) Public Act 05-172 requires the commissioner to adopt regulations to establish requirements for a strike contingency plan and for imposing the civil penalty upon a nursing facility. (C) The proposed regulation amends section 19a-527-1 and section 19a-527-2 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies for consistency and accuracy.

Effective: July 3, 2007

Short-Term Hospitals, General and Special –

(A) The purpose of the regulation is to revise and update section 19-13-D3 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies. The revisions delete outdated requirements and make the regulations consistent with current health care service delivery standards. (B) The proposed regulation modifies existing hospital standards for maternity and obstetric services, departments and department heads, psychiatric services and hospital infection control programs. (C) The proposed regulation amends section 19-13-D3 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies.
