STATE REGULATIONS APPROVED

The following regulations were approved by the Legislative Regulation Review Committee:

Smoking Prohibition in Places Dispensing Food or Beverages and Catering Food Service

Establishments - To amend the smoking restriction provisions in Public Health Code Section 19-13-B42(p)(2) and the food inspection forms contained in Public Health Code Sections 19-13-B42(t)(6) and 19-13-B49(u)(6) to be consistent with the smoking prohibition requirements of Public Act 03-45 and to highlight in red the risk factors for food borne disease. To amend the inspection forms contained in 19-13-B48(l)(6) to be consistent with the forms in 19-13-B42(t)(6) and 19-13-B49(u)(6) and to amend Public Health Code Sections 19-13-B42(v)(6), 19-13-B48(m)(6), and 19-13-B49(v)(6) to be consistent with the appeal provisions of Public Act 03-252, and to amend the name of the department in the definition section of 19-13-B48(a)(2) and 19-13-B48(a)(3).

Effective: October 3, 2005

Revision of School Hepatitis immunization

Requirements - To modify the existing regulatory language of 10-204a-2a of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies to be consistent with national recommendations for timing of administration of Hepatitis B vaccine.

Effective: October 3, 2005

Access to Clinical Laboratory Reports -

To revise subsection (a) of section 19a-36-D32 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies to allow authorized health care practitioners other than the ordering practitioner to receive copies of a patient's laboratory test results directly from laboratories other than the Department's laboratory.

Effective: October 3, 2005

Repeal of Shellfish Regulations - Public Act 89-321 transferred sections 19a-96 through 19a-101, inclusive, to Chapter 491, thereby transferring the regulatory authority for enforcing shellfish regulations to the State of Connecticut Department of Agriculture making these regulations obsolete. Sections 19-13-B71 and 19-13-B72 will be retained.

Effective: October 28, 2005

Medical Protocol for the Administration of Influenza and Pneumococcal Polysaccharide Vaccines for Patients in Hospitals - Public Act 04-164 requires the Commissioner to develop regulations which allow a hospital to administer influenza and pneumococcal vaccines to patients, without a physician's order in accordance with a physician-approved hospital policy.
Effective: October 28, 2005

Continuing Education for Clinical Social Workers and Chiropractors - To revise mandatory continuing education requirements for clinical social workers to allow for the completion of distance learning and Internet-based educational programs and provide waiver provisions for individuals having a medical disability or illness; and to revise mandatory continuing education requirements for chiropractors to clarify the requirements for self-assessment programs.

Effective: December 5, 2005

Family Campgrounds - To update family campground regulations to provide consistency with existing and current practices.
