Re: Snyder Industries, Inc. Dominator Septic Tanks

Dear Mr. Spann:

This Department has received the new specification drawings for Snyder Industries' Dominator septic tanks series. Correspondence from your company indicated that minor dimensional modifications have been made to the product line, and new part numbers have also been given to each of the various Dominator tanks. This Department previously approved Snyder Industries' Dominator septic tanks. This Department has been advised that the NuConSept tank series are no longer produced by Snyder Industries and your distributors have depleted the stock of the NuConSept tanks.

This Department has updated the approved list (Appendix D) of non-concrete septic tanks to reflect the discontinuation of the NuConSept tanks, and the new designations for the Dominator tanks. Attached is a copy of Appendix D, revised March 1, 2010, of the Technical Standards for Subsurface Sewage Disposal Systems. This Department will distribute the updated appendix to local health departments in the State of Connecticut, and to our Code Advisory Committee, which includes representation from the sewage system installer and designer associations. The updated appendix will also be posted on the Department's website.

Also, as noted in our approval of the Dominator tanks, all non-concrete septic tanks distributed in the State of Connecticut must include installation instructions, and each approved tank manufacturer is responsible for ensuring up-to-date installation instructions are on file with this Department.
