Please see the attached product recall issued by CPSC. The products (Military toy figures) are imported by Jide Trading, Inc., of Commerce, Calif. The surface paint on the toy contains excessive levels of lead violating the federal lead paint standard. Lead is toxic if ingested by young children and can cause adverse health effects.

This recall involves the mini military toy set which is packaged on a blister card and includes a male military figure about four inches in height with various accessories.

The figures were sold at dollar stores and other discount stores from November 2008 to April 2009. They were manufactured in China.
