Attorney Mary Alice Moore Leonhardt was present on behalf of Dr. Corvo. Dr. Veleas made a motion, seconded by Dr. Cutler, to approve the Consent Order. The motion passed unanimously. Dr. Pressman signed the Order which imposes a civil penalty of \$1000.00.
