<p>As part of an ongoing and extensive investigation into illegal narcotics trafficking in the Borough of Jewett City and the surrounding area, six more local men were arrested on Monday, January 26th at approximately 1510 hours and Tuesday, January 27th at approximately 1810 hours. Two of the men arrested were major suppliers of powder cocaine and crack cocaine in the Jewett City area. Arrested for Possession of Cocaine With Intent To Sell and Operating a Drug Factory was a Phillip Chester Obriskie.</p> <p>Information developed indicated that narcotics distributors from the Plainfield, Willmantic, and Norwich areas are targeting the Jewett City area. Approximately 1 ounce of powder cocaine packaged for sale, as well as cash and packaging equipment were seized in the arrests. Also, a residence was allegedly being used as a drug factory to mix, weigh and package powder cocaine for street-level sales. Also arrested for Sale of Crack Cocaine was a Clayton Ballinger</p> <p>The other four suspects arrested in the sweep were Marianne Elizabeth McGarvey, Frederick Charles Marsh, Mark Patrick Caputo, and John Robert Lapointe. Investigation into the illegal drug trafficking will continue and the arrests are expected to focus on the higher-level narcotics supply network.</p> <p>Troopers from the Jewett City Resident Trooper's office began an extensive investigation last Fall. The investigation was launched as a result of tips from concerned citizens and police intelligence operations. Initial investigation focused on two bars that were suspected of providing a haven for drug use and sales. Routine bar checks were conducted concurrent to the investigation and resulted in narcotics arrests at both locations. From mid November of last year to January 27th of this year, 26 drug related arrests, 21 of which were serious felony arrests were made based on investigations initiated by the Jewett City Resident Trooper's along with the assistance of the Statewide Narcotics Task Force. As a result of these arrests, 2 1/2 ounces of unpackaged heroin was seized as well as 80 packaged bags of heroin, over \$10,000 in cash, 1 vehicle, and a Ruger Mini 14 rifle with ammunition.</p> <p>Resident Troopers conducting the investigation report that heroin is an emerging threat to the community in addition to crack cocaine. Information has also been developed and Troopers are presently investigating the sale and abuse of prescribed drugs such as OxyContin and Morphine.</p>
