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The following clarifications are applicable to drawings and specifications for the project referenced above.

Item 1

The BID OPENING DATE is hereby changed from September 30, 2009 to **October 14, 2009**. Bids will be received UNTIL 1:00 P.M.

Item 2

REPLACE Specification Section 00020 BID PROPOSAL FORM provided in ADDENDUM #1 in its entirety with the attached **revised** Section 00020 BID PROPOSAL FORM in ADDENDUM #2.

Item 3

REPLACE Specification Section 02361 Timber Piles in its entirety with the attached.

Item 4

Section 00010 Invitation to Bid and Section 01010 Summary of Work, Paragraph 6.2 of the General Requirements:

CHANGE the Contract Time Allowed from 330 Calendar Days to 400 Calendar Days. The Contract Time Allowed includes the time duration associated with the suspension of Work as specified in Specification Section 01010.

Item 5

General Requirements, Section 01505 Temporary Electricity and Lighting

ADD to Paragraph A: "Temporary electric power is available at the City of Milford sewage pump station adjacent to the Walnut Beach (City of Milford) parking area on the east side of Viscount Drive."

Item 6

General Requirements, Section 01580 Field Office and Shed, ADD the following:

- B. A temporary field office may be located in the northeast corner of the Walnut Beach (City of Milford) parking area on the east side of Viscount Drive as designated by the Construction Administrator.

- C. A land-line phone and Fax Machine will not be required for the temporary field office provided that the designated Project Superintendant shall have a cell phone for the duration of the work in lieu of such land-line phone.

Item 7

Note the following clarifications applicable to Drawings EC-1 through EC-9 (Existing Conditions Plans) and Drawings LM-1 through LM-9 (Layout and Materials Plans):

The Brushline along the beach area as depicted on Drawings EC-1 through EC-9 and Drawings LM-1 through LM-9 may vary from present field conditions. The Department of Environmental Protection is currently implementing a phragmite eradication program which has altered the extent of vegetation in the vicinity of the proposed boardwalk.

Item 8

Note the following clarification applicable to Drawings LM-1 and LM-2:

Removal of the existing snow fence/wire fence, concrete block barriers, and signage located on the north side of the Walnut Beach dune, extending between Stations 0+07 +/- and Station 8+70 +/- will be removed by others and is excluded from the Contractor's scope of work.

Item 9

On Drawings LM-1 and LM-2, ADD the following:

"The scope of work for construction of Beach Access No. 1 and Beach Access No. 2 includes removal of the existing wooden walkways."

Item 10

On Drawing DT-9, Note the following clarification for the Dune Barrier construction:

Fasteners for the connection between the 2" x 4" pressure treated intermediate, or mid-rail, and the 4" x4" pressure treated intermediate post, or as applicable, 6" x6" pressure treated wood post (every third rail) shall consist of stainless steel deck screws. No carriage bolts are intended for these connections.

Item 11

Drawing DT-9, Note the following clarification for the Guardrail construction:

Fasteners for the connection between the 2" x 4" pressure treated intermediate, or mid-rail, and the 4" x4" pressure treated intermediate post, or as applicable, 6" x6" pressure treated wood post (every third rail) shall consist of stainless steel deck screws. No carriage bolts are intended for these connections.

Item 12

For informational purposes only: Department of Environmental Protection reports that nesting piping plover pairs were sighted in Years 2007, 2008, and 2009 at Silver Sands State Park.

Item 13

REPLACE Section 01019 Contract Considerations, Paragraph B.2.c in its entirety with the following:

"c. Increases or Decreases: Should the amount of the Work required be increased or decreased because of changes in the work ordered in writing by the Project Manager, the Undersigned agrees that all UNIT PRICES as defined in the Bid Proposal Form and Specifications will be used to determine the cost of the increase or decrease in work."



- 1.0 In accordance with Chapter 60 Part II of the Connecticut General Statutes, as amended, and pursuant to, and in compliance with your Invitation to Bid, the Notice to Bidders, the Contract, including the conditions thereto, the Bid Security, I (we) propose to furnish the labor and/or materials, installed as required for the project named and numbered on this Bid Proposal Form, submitted herein, furnishing all necessary equipment, machinery, tools, labor and other means of construction, and all materials specified in the manner and at the time prescribed strictly in accordance with the provisions of the Contract including, but not limited to, the specifications and/or drawings together with all addenda issued by your authority and received prior to the scheduled closing time for the receipt of the bids, and in conformity with requirements of the Awarding Authority and any laws or Departmental regulations of the State of Connecticut or of the United States which may affect the same, for and in consideration of the price(s) stated on the said Bid Proposal Form, hereof.
- 2.0 The **Lump Sum Base Bid** by me (us) on the Bid Proposal Form *includes* all work indicated on the drawings and/or described in the specifications, *except*:
- 2.1 Work covered by **Supplemental Bids** as may be listed on the Bid Proposal Form and General Requirements.
- 2.2 Contingent Work covered by the **Unit Prices** included within the General Requirements.
- 2.3 Contingent Work covered by the **Contractor Provided Unit Prices** as may be listed on the Bid Proposal Form in Section 00020, Item 7.7.

- 3.0 I (we) *acknowledge* and *agree* to the following:
- 3.1 To use and accept the **Contractor Provided Unit Prices** on the Bid Proposal Form, Section 00020, Item 7.7, as provided by the Contractor in evaluating either additions to or deductions from the Work.
 - 3.2 To use and accept the **Unit Prices** in Section 01019 "Contract Considerations" Division 1 as provided by the Owner in evaluating either additions to or deductions from the Work.
 - 3.3 To use and accept the **Allowances** in Section 01019 "Contract Considerations" Division 1, as part of the Total Contract Sum as listed in Section 7.3 of this Bid Proposal form.
 - 3.4 To use and accept the **Supplemental Bids** in Section 01030, Division 1, as provided by the Contractor, when authorized by the Owner as scheduled in Section 7.6 of this Bid proposal form.
 - 3.5 To complete and submit a **Contractor/Consultant Certification** along with a **Resolution/Certificate of Authority** for contracts with a value of \$50,000 or more when requested in the **Letter of Intent**.

This certification must be *updated annually* by the *successful* bidder. **Annually**, on or within two (2) weeks of the **anniversary** date of the execution of this contract, the Contractor shall submit a completed **Annual Certification** with authorizing resolution to DPW, 165 Capitol Ave., Room G-35, Hartford, CT 06106. For the purposes of this paragraph, the execution date of the contract will be the date the Commissioner of DPW signs the contract.

- 3.6 To hold the bid price for ninety (90) calendar days and any extensions caused by the Contractor's delays in required submissions. The Contractor and the State may mutually agree to extend this period.

The apparent low bidder is required to submit key supporting documents as noted under the caption **Bid Submittal Time Line** at the end of this Section 00020, within ten (10) calendar days of the bid opening, and to submit their Affirmative Action Plan to CHRO within fifteen (15) calendar days of bid opening. If there are any delays in the receipt of these materials then the Bid shall remain valid for the same additional number of days. For example, if the materials are submitted four (4) days later; then the bid shall remain valid for ninety-four (94) days.

- 3.7 With regard to a State contract as defined in **P.A. 07-01** having a value in a calendar year of \$50,000 or more or a combination or series of such **agreements** or **contracts** having a value of \$100,000 or more, the **authorized signatory** to this **submission** in response to the State's solicitation expressly **acknowledges** receipt of the **State Election Enforcement Commission's notice** advising prospective state contractors of the state campaign contribution and solicitation prohibitions, and will inform its principals of the contents of the **notice**. See Attachment **SEEC Form 11**.

- 3.8** The **unit and lump sum prices** *include* all labor, materials, transportation, hauling, bailing, shoring and bracing, demolition and removals, surveying and engineering, overhead, fees and insurances, profit, and all other costs to cover the finished work of the several kinds called for in **Division 1 General Requirements** and *elsewhere* in the **Contract Documents**. No additional payment of any kind in the form of a surcharge will be made for work provided under the unit/lump sum prices, as bid.
- 3.9 In regard to all conditions affecting the WORK to be done and the labor and materials to be furnished, this BID is based solely on the BIDDER'S investigations and findings and neither the OWNER nor the ENGINEER nor their officers, employees or agents shall be held responsible for the accuracy of, or be bound by any information contained in these Contract Documents including, but not limited to, soil boring information relative to rock, water or other subsurface conditions related to the WORK; that no warranty or representation has been made by the OWNER or the ENGINEER as to subsurface soil or rock conditions, ground water or other underground and similar conditions.
- 4.0 This Bid Proposal Form is submitted to and in compliance with the foregoing and following conditions and/or information:
- 4.1 AWARD
- 4.1.1 All proposals shall be subject to provisions of **Article 1 of the Notice to Bidders** and for purpose of award, consideration shall be given only to Bid Proposals submitted by qualified and responsible bidders.
- 4.1.2 The award shall be made on the **lowest Lump Sum Bid** as stated in Section 7.3 of this Bid Proposal Form and any or all **Supplemental Bids** as stated in Section 7.6 of this **Bid Proposal Form**, taken sequentially, as applicable, provided funds are available.
- 4.1.3 In the event of any discrepancy between the amount written in words and the amount written in numerical figures, the amount written in words shall be controlling.
- 4.2 COMMENCEMENT AND FINAL COMPLETION OF WORK: (ARTICLE 4 GENERAL CONDITIONS)
- 4.2.1 The General Contractor shall commence Work within fourteen (14) calendar days after receiving "Construction Start Date and Notice To Proceed" by the Commissioner or the authorized representative and continue for four hundred **(400)** calendar days for completion of the project.
- 4.3 LIQUIDATED DAMAGES: (ARTICLE 8, GENERAL CONDITIONS)
- 4.3.1 The General Contractor shall be assessed **Four Hundred (\$400.00) Dollars in Liquidated Damages** per day for each calendar day beyond the Date given for Final Completion of the Contract according to the Contract Time.

- 4.4 CONTRACTOR'S INSURANCE REQUIRED: (ARTICLE 36, GENERAL CONDITIONS)
- 4.4.1 The limits of liability for the Insurance required for this project shall be those listed in Article 36 of the General Conditions. The insurance certificate shall have the State of Connecticut and the City of Milford as additionally insured.
- 4.4.2 SPECIAL HAZARDS INSURANCE REQUIRED:
- Type "X", "C", "U" – Explosion, Collapse, Underground in accordance with Article 36 of the General Conditions.
- 4.4.3 BUILDERS RISK INSURANCE
- The General Contractor shall maintain Builder's Risk insurance providing coverage for the entire Work at the project site, and shall also cover portions of the Work located away from the site but intended for use at the site, and shall also cover portions of the Work in transit. Coverage shall be written on an All-Risk, Replacement Cost, and completed Value Form basis in an amount at least equal to the projected completed value of the Work and the policy shall state that it is for the benefit of and payable to the State of Connecticut.
- 4.5 The General Contractor on this project shall be required to perform not less than 25% of the completed Contract Sum of the **Work with its own forces**.
- 4.6 Good Faith Effort – MBE/WBE Participation
- 4.7 BIDDER'S QUALIFICATION STATEMENT AND OBJECTIVE CRITERIA FOR EVALUATING QUALIFICATIONS OF BIDDERS:
- 4.7.1 Information in regards to the General Contractor's and the Named Subcontractor's Bidder's Qualification is submitted and is made part of this Bid Proposal Form. **Note: Individual Specification Sections may contain General Contractor and/or Subcontractor Qualification requirements that exceed those in Section 00040, "Objective Criteria Established for Evaluating Qualifications of Bidders."**
- 4.7.1.1 The General Contractor is required to complete the General Contractor Bidder's Qualification Statement in section 00030.
- 4.7.1.2 Any Named Subcontractor as listed in schedule 7.5.1 of this Bid Proposal Form is required to complete the Named Subcontractor Bidder's Qualification Statement in section 00035. To facilitate compliance with this requirement, the three (3) apparent low bidders will have ten (10) calendar days, from the bid opening date, to submit the completed Named Subcontractor Bidder's Qualification Statement as required in section 00035. This information will be considered as part of your Bid Proposal Form and failure to comply with any portion of this requirement will be cause to reject your bid.

4.7.2 The Objective Criteria for Evaluating Bidders that are included in Division 0, Section 00040, of this Project Manual, is to assure that the State of Connecticut will secure the "lowest responsible and qualified bidder" who has the ability and capacity to successfully complete the Bid Proposal Form and the Work.

4.8 **NONDISCRIMINATION AND LABOR RECRUITMENT:**

4.8.1 The Contract is subject to the provisions of Executive Order No. Three of Governor Thomas J. Meskill, promulgated June 16, 1971, concerning labor employment practices, Executive Order No. Seventeen of Governor Thomas J. Meskill, promulgated February 15, 1973, concerning the listing of employment openings and Executive Order No. Sixteen of Governor John G. Rowland promulgated August 4, 1999, concerning violence in the workplace, all of which are incorporated into and are made a part of the Contract as if they had been fully set forth in it. At the Contractor's request, the Client Agency shall provide a copy of these orders to the Contractor. The Contract may also be subject to Executive Order No. 7C of Governor M. Jodi Rell, promulgated July 13, 2006, concerning contracting reforms and Executive Order No. 14 of Governor M. Jodi Rell, promulgated April 17, 2006, concerning procurement of cleaning products and services, in accordance with their respective terms and conditions.

4.9 **FEDERAL & STATE WAGE DETERMINATIONS:**

4.9.1 The U. S. Secretary of Labor's latest decision and the State of Connecticut Wage Schedule are all incorporated in the documents. The higher rate (Federal or State) for any given occupation shall prevail. At the time of bidding, the bidder agrees to accept the current prevailing wage scale, as well as the annual adjustment to the prevailing wage scale, as provided by the Connecticut Department of Labor.

4.10 **CERTIFICATION OF BIDDER REGARDING EQUAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY & NON-SEGREGATED FACILITIES:**

4.10.1 The General Contractor and Subcontractors are hereby advised that upon acceptance of their bids they are obligated to fill out within seven (7) calendar days the certification required pursuant to Executive Order No. 11246, and agree to certify to the compliance of non-segregated facilities.

4.11 **EQUALS AND/OR SUBSTITUTIONS:**

4.11.1 All submissions requesting "Equals and/or Substitutions" shall be made by the Contractor in accordance with Article 15 of the General Conditions and Section 01631 of the General Requirements. All submissions shall contain all the information necessary for the Department of Public Works to evaluate the submission and the request. Failure to submit sufficient information to make a proper evaluation, including submittal of data for the first manufacturer listed as well as the data for the "Equals and/or Substitutions" proposed, shall result in a rejection of the submission and request. Upon receipt of the submission and request the Department of Public Works shall notify the Contractor the request

has been received and within fourteen (14) calendar days of date received shall render a decision on such submission and request.

5.0 ACCOMPANYING THIS PROPOSAL IS:

5.1 A CERTIFIED CHECK drawn to the order of – Treasurer, State of Connecticut, in the which it is understood shall be cashed and the proceeds thereof used so far as may be necessary to reimburse the State of Connecticut for losses and damages arising by virtue of my (our) failure to file the required Bonds and execute the required contract if this proposal is accepted by the Awarding Authority.



PART 1 GENERAL

1.1 WORK INCLUDED

- A. Mobilize the necessary equipment, materials, tools, and labor to furnish & drive Pressure Treated Timber piles to the tip elevations specified on the plans.
- B. Lay out piles using a Connecticut-registered Professional Land Surveyor. Provide a surveyed as-built pile location plan stamped by a Connecticut-registered Professional Land Surveyor for review and approval prior to beginning any timber framing.
- C. Advancing piles through obstructions by excavating and removing the obstructions, by pre-augering, by spudding, or by whatever means is necessary to install the piles in accordance with the plans and these specifications.
- D. Cutting off pile tops to required elevations.
- E. Excavation and backfilling in order to install piles to the design elevations shown on the plans, so that pile caps and stringers can be installed to the required elevations.

1.2 UNIT PRICES

- A. Unit prices for certain work of this Section are listed on a page in the General Documents that precede the technical specifications. The Contractor and DPW Construction Administrator will verify the actual quantity used.
 - 1. Timber Piles- State of Connecticut Property
 - a. 12-inch pile with a tip elevation at -15 feet.
 - 1) The base bid shall include the installation of 42, 12-inch piles with a tip elevation at -15 feet.
 - 2) Contractor shall provide and install 12-inch timber piles with tip elevation at -15 feet. The work of 12-inch timber pile installation with tip elevation to -15 feet shall include all labor, equipment, materials, incidentals and overhead costs associated with a complete installation of the pile to a tip elevation of -15 measured to the nearest 0.5 foot.
 - 3) This item will be measured for payment on a per pile unit price basis to be measured as the actual number of piles installed as verified by the DPW Construction Administrator. No additional payment will be made under unit pricing for additional piles that are installed as a result of mishandling, carelessness, or piles driven out of tolerance under the base bid.

- b. 12-inch pile with a tip elevation at -25 feet.
 - 1) The base bid shall include the installation of 359, 12-inch piles with a tip elevation at -25 feet. This item includes 60 piles for Beach Access 3, 4, 5, and 6.
 - 2) Contractor shall provide and install 12-inch timber piles with tip elevation at -25 feet. The work of 12-inch timber pile installation with tip elevation to -25 feet shall include all labor, equipment, materials, incidentals and overhead costs associated with a complete installation of the pile to a tip elevation of -25 measured to the nearest 0.5 foot.
 - 3) This item will be measured for payment on a per pile unit price basis to be measured as the actual number of piles installed as verified by the DPW Construction Administrator. No additional payment will be made under unit pricing for additional piles that are installed as a result of mishandling, carelessness, or piles driven out of tolerance under the base bid.

- c. 15-inch pile with a tip elevation at -20 feet.
 - 1) The base bid shall include the installation of 5, 15-inch piles with a tip elevation at -20 feet.
 - 2) Contractor shall provide and install 15-inch timber piles with tip elevation at -20 feet. The work of 15-inch timber pile installation with tip elevation to -20 feet shall include all labor, equipment, materials, incidentals and overhead costs associated with a complete installation of the pile to a tip elevation of -20 measured to the nearest 0.5 foot.
 - 3) This item will be measured for payment on a per pile unit price basis to be measured as the actual number of piles installed as verified by the DPW Construction Administrator. No additional payment will be made under unit pricing for additional piles that are installed as a result of mishandling, carelessness, or piles driven out of tolerance under the base bid.

- d. 15-inch pile with a tip elevation at -30 feet.
 - 1) The base bid shall include the installation of 5, 15-inch piles with a tip elevation at -30 feet.
 - 2) Contractor shall provide and install 15-inch timber piles with tip elevation at -30 feet. The work of 15-inch timber pile installation with tip elevation to -30 feet shall include all labor, equipment, materials, incidentals and overhead costs associated with a complete installation of the pile to a tip elevation of -30 measured to the nearest 0.5 foot.

- 3) This item will be measured for payment on a per pile unit price basis to be measured as the actual number of piles installed as verified by the DPW Construction Administrator. No additional payment will be made under unit pricing for additional piles that are installed as a result of mishandling, carelessness, or piles driven out of tolerance under the base bid.

2. Timber Piles- City of Milford Property

a. 12-inch pile with a tip elevation at -15 feet.

- 1) The base bid shall include the installation of 139, 12-inch piles with a tip elevation at -15 feet.
- 2) Contractor shall provide and install 12-inch timber piles with tip elevation at -15 feet. The work of 12-inch timber pile installation with tip elevation to -15 feet shall include all labor, equipment, materials, incidentals and overhead costs associated with a complete installation of the pile to a tip elevation of -15 measured to the nearest 0.5 foot.
- 3) This item will be measured for payment on a per pile unit price basis to be measured as the actual number of piles installed as verified by the DPW Construction Administrator. No additional payment will be made under unit pricing for additional piles that are installed as a result of mishandling, carelessness, or piles driven out of tolerance under the base bid.

1.5 SUBMITTALS

- A. Submit Shop Drawings under provisions of Section 01300.
- B. Indicate details and schedule of pile installation.
- C. Submit a wave equation analysis of pile driving that demonstrates that pile stresses from the driving hammer are less than 3,600 pounds per square inch in tension or compression. Submit with the wave equation analysis manufacturer's data supporting the input parameters for the hammer used in the wave equation analysis. The wave equation analysis shall be completed and the results stamped by a Connecticut registered professional engineer experienced in performing wave equation analyses. Piles shall be driven to the minimum required elevations irrespective of blow count criteria, except when number of blows per inch results in driving stresses that exceed 3,600 psi, and that this blow count does not occur from a shallow (less than 15-foot deep) obstruction.
- D. Submit certification by a licensed testing laboratory that piles were free of decay; properly peeled and prepared for treatment; and indicates method of treatment, chemical composition and amount of retention of the preservative.
- E. Submit a plan for review and approval showing surveyed, as-built pile locations prior to beginning any framing of the boardwalk. The plan shall be prepared and stamped by a Connecticut-registered Professional Land Surveyor.

1.6 PROJECT RECORD DOCUMENTS

- A. Submit 5 copies of Project Records and Drawings under applicable provisions of Division 01.
- B. Accurately record:
 - 1. Date of driving pile.
 - 2. Bent number, sizes, lengths, and pile location within each bent.
 - 3. Sequence of driving.
 - 4. Number of blows per foot for the entire length of pile and blows per inch for final twelve inches (12") of penetration.
 - 5. Identify locations and depths where obstructions are encountered and the methods used to advance the piles beyond the obstructions.
 - 6. Final tip and butt elevations.

7. Hammer Used and rated energy of hammer blow. Submit a neat, legible pile driving log for each pile installed.
8. Submit a final record drawing of all surveyed locations of the piles with the pile numbers on the drawing matching the pile numbers on the logs.

1.6 PROJECT CONDITIONS

- A. Protect nearby structures and resource areas (beach, wetlands) from damage. All construction induced damage shall be repaired by the Contractor to the satisfaction of the Construction Administrator at no additional expense to the Owner.
- B. Perform driving during the hours of 8 am and 4 pm.
- C. Visit site to review all details of the work and working conditions, to verify dimensions in the field including interferences from adjacent structures utilities, and to advise the Engineer of any discrepancy before performing any work.
- D. Consult official records of existing utilities, both surface and subsurface, and their connection, to be fully informed on all existing conditions and limitations as they apply to this Work and its relation to other construction work.
- E. Protect existing utilities to remain in accordance with the requirements of authorities having jurisdiction over same.

1.7 SUBSURFACE SOIL DATA

- A. Boring logs are provided in the contract drawings. After obtaining Owner's permission, take whatever additional borings or explorations deemed necessary at no expense to Owner.
- B. Boring logs are included in Appendix 1 (Geotechnical Report, Silver Sands State Park and Walnut Beach, Milford, Connecticut by GZA GeoEnvironmental, Inc. dated July 2007).
- C. The boring logs are for general information and are accurate only at the particular locations that the subsurface explorations were made. It is the Contractor's responsibility to make interpretations and draw conclusions based on the character of materials to be encountered and the impact on his work based on his expert knowledge of the area and of pile installation techniques.

1.8 PROTECTION

- A. Prevent surface damage to treated piles.
- B. Make repairs to treated piles in accordance with AWWA M4.

1.9 QUALITY ASSURANCE

- A. Provide written statement verifying at least three (3) years experience in this type of installation and the competence and experience of the person in charge at the site.
- B. Provide written statement naming at least three (3) comparable installations, identifying Design Consultant and Owner's name.
- C. Approval of the Contractor and installation method shall be based solely on the judgment of the Engineer. These approvals shall in no way imply acceptance of responsibility by the Engineer for the Contractor's ability to perform the work.
- D. Employ, within the Contract Price, a Connecticut-Licensed Land Surveyor familiar with this type of work to:
 - 1. Establish lines and grades.
 - 2. Establish actual pile locations.
 - 3. Keep up-to-date records of heave of individual piles.
 - 4. Show locations of centers of as-driven piles on a drawing in relation to the design location.
 - 5. Determine elevation to the nearest five hundreds of a foot (0.05') at the butt of pile prior to cutting and the tip of the pile.

PART 2 PRODUCTS

2.1 MATERIALS

- A. Piles shall be preservative-treated, clean peeled southern pine pressure impregnated with 2.5 pounds per cubic foot of Chromated Copper Arsenate (CCA) preservative treatment.
- B. Piles shall meet the requirements of ASTM D25 round timber piles, with minimum tip diameter of 6 inches. Splices will not be permitted.

PART 3 EXECUTION

3.1 PREPARATION

- A. Obtain prior review of hammer to be used. Use driving method which will not cause damage to nearby structures and utilities.
- B. Verify site conditions will support driving equipment for performance of pile driving operation and testing.

- C. Perform up to four wave equation analyses to demonstrate that pile stresses from the driving hammer are less than 3,600 pounds per square inch in tension or compression. Submit with the wave equation analysis manufacturer's data supporting the input parameters for the hammer used in the wave equation analysis. The wave equation analysis shall be completed and the results stamped by a Connecticut registered professional engineer experienced in performing wave equation analyses. Piles shall be driven to the minimum required elevations irrespective of the blow count criteria, except when number of blows per inch results in driving stresses that exceed 3,600 psi, and that this blow count does not occur from a shallow (less than 15-foot deep) obstruction.
- D. Excavate at the locations and to the depths required for pile cut-off and to place timber pile caps to the elevations indicated on the drawings. Backfill in accordance with Section 02200 - Earthwork.

3.2 DRIVING EQUIPMENT

- A. Use steam, air, or diesel hammers, having a rated energy consistent with the results of the wave equation analysis. Maintain the valve mechanism and other parts of hammers in a condition which will ensure that the length of stroke and number of blows per minute for which the hammer is designed will be realized. Steam and air hammers shall have boiler/air capacity which is not less than that specified by the hammer manufacturer; boiler and compressor shall have either pressure gauges or other devices calibrated in a manner which will allow hammer energy to be determined. When the determination of the final driving resistance is being made, operate hammer at a speed not less than ninety-five percent (95%) of the maximum blows per minute as rated by the manufacturer. Maintain the boiler or air pressure recommended by the manufacturer and employ hose and connections of the proper sizes. For diesel hammers, have a bounce pressure gage or markings on the ram to permit measurement of actual hammer operating energy.
- B. Fix leads of the pile-driving rig at two (2) points. The points shall be at least half of the length of the leads apart in order to maintain the pile and hammer in axial alignment at the correct plan location during the entire driving operation. Extend leads down to the lowest point at which the hammer must operate. The use of followers will not be permitted.
- C. Use cap block cushion as recommended by the hammer manufacturer. Do not use cushions of asbestos or wire rope.
- D. The proposed pile-driving equipment is subject to the approval of the Engineer. Secure approval before pile-driving starts. Use the same equipment for all production piles and test piles. Approval by the Engineer of the Contractor's equipment merely signifies that the Contractor may make an initial trial installation with the proposed equipment. Approval will not relieve the Contractor of his responsibility for providing and installing piles capable of supporting the design loads by whatever means necessary without damage to the piles, including changing the equipment and procedures from those used in the initial trial.

3.3 INSTALLATION

- A. Protect head of piles with appropriately sized and fitted steel driving helmet.
- B. Position helmet for uniform distribution of hammer blow.
- C. Deliver hammer blows on central axis of pile.
- D. Provide full bearing on piles for distribution of hammer blow. Do not damage piles during driving operations.
- E. Drive piles into the specified bearing stratum. Avoid damaging piles by overdriving. Cease driving if less than one inch (1") penetration under five (5) blows of hammer operating at full rated energy (virtual refusal).
- F. Driving Criteria: Final driving criteria will depend on the hammer used.
- G. When driving is interrupted before achieving final driving criteria in the specified bearing stratum, drive an additional six inches (6") before recording performance data. Do not overdrive.
- H. Pile Heave:
 - 1. Immediately after driving, set a reference elevation on each pile to an accuracy of one-hundredth (0.01) foot. After driving all piles within fifteen feet of pile cap locations, check reference elevations on adjacent pile caps.
 - 2. Redrive any pile showing more than .04 foot (1/2 inch) heave.
 - 3. Redrive piles a minimum of two inches (2") or virtual refusal, whichever occurs first.
 - 4. If pile penetrates less than two inches (2") after virtual refusal at full rated energy, stop driving.
 - 5. Otherwise, redrive pile at least to original tip elevation and thereafter to original final driving resistance with hammer operating at full rated energy.
- I. Prepare pile top to receive timber pile cap.
- J. Apply preservative to exposed ends of cut-off piles.

3.4 OBSTRUCTIONS

Obstructions were encountered in the test borings in the vicinity of boring GZ-2. The alignment of the project extends along a former City street.

- A. Where obstructions impede installation of piles at the required locations shown on the drawings to the required depths, resort to all usual methods for pile installation, including excavation, spudding and pre-augering. Prior to pile driving, excavate to

depths up to 15 feet (15') and remove obstructions and backfill in accordance with Section 02200. The cost of excavation of obstructions less the 1 cubic yard in volume to a depth of ten feet (10') shall be included as part of Section 02200. If, in the judgment of the Engineer, the Contractor is unable to complete the proper installation of any pile, by and after resorting to such methods, the Engineer may order that an additional pile or piles be driven or that other remedial action be taken, for which the Contractor will be paid in accordance with the unit prices established in this contract. Cut at cutoff elevation or pull out any pile abandoned because of obstructions encountered before reaching the anticipated depth. Fill the open hole with concrete or soil at the discretion of the Engineer and at no cost to the Owner.

- B. If the Engineer determines that obstructions more than fifteen 15 feet (15') below cutoff elevation or greater than one cubic yard (1 cu yd) in volume should be removed by excavation, the Contractor will be reimbursed for the additional work of removing obstructions and backfilling on a time and material basis. No additional payment for removal of any obstruction will be made unless approval of such work, including agreement for extra compensation for such, has been made in writing by the Engineer in advance of execution of the work.
- C. Cut off or pull out at the discretion of the Engineer, piles abandoned because of obstructions. In either case, the Contractor will be paid on a per pile basis for those piles which cannot be driven to the required depth by the "usual methods."

3.5 TOLERANCES

- A. Top: Maximum three inches (3") from location indicated.
- B. Cut-off: Cut level for placement of pile cap.
- C. Piles batter: One (1) in twelve (12) from vertical for plumb piles.

3.6 NON-CONFORMING PILES

- A. Non-conforming Piles: Piles that fail tests, are installed out of tolerance, are below cut-off elevation, are damaged, or are not driven to specified bearing stratum. Suspected broken piles, based on driving logs, whose break cannot be verified because of depth will be rejected by the Engineer.
- B. Provide additional piles or supplement piles to meet specified requirements, as/if requested by the Construction Administrator.
- C. Pull out and replace or cutoff piles which break above ground surface or within ten feet (10') of ground surface.

3.7 FIELD QUALITY CONTROL

- A. Drive all piles in the presence of the Construction Administrator.

- B. All work will be subject to observation, logging, and tests by the Construction Administrator.

- D. Mark each pile in readily visible one foot (1') intervals from the tip. Mark each five feet (5') with a numeral. Mark one inch (1") intervals near the butt of the segment where final take-up is expected. Alternatively provide a rule marked in inches close to each driven pile to permit observation of the final penetration blows per inch.



4.2.1 The General Contractor shall commence Work within fourteen (14) calendar days after receiving "Construction Start Date and Notice To Proceed" by the Commissioner or the authorized representative and continue for Three Hundred and Thirty (330) calendar days for completion of the project.
