Eligibility

Enrollees must:

- Be a resident of Connecticut
- Be a U.S. citizen or U.S. national, or lawfully present (as defined by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security)
- Be uninsured for the past six months, unless currently insured by another state- or federally-operated pre-existing condition insurance plan
- Have a qualifying pre-existing health condition, such as high blood pressure, diabetes or kidney disease
