Synopsis:

During her stay, Reid meets Dan, a family friend whose van has broken down, forcing him to also stay at the house until his vehicle is repaired. Reid quickly develops a friendship with Dan, and as she learns from him, she questions whether she is making her own decisions or if she is simply trying to meet others' expectations of her.

Character BIOS:

[DAN] [GENDER: MALE] [AGE: 25-30]

Dan is a modern nomad who lives out of his van. As he moves around so much, he tends to keep to himself and not form close ties. Although he appears mildly eccentric, he has a clear view of the world and of those he encounters.

[LAUREN] [GENDER: FEMALE] [AGE: 25-30]

[SABRINA] [GENDER: FEMALE] [AGE: 21-26]

[MOM] [GENDER: FEMALE] [AGE: 48-65]

Reid's mom wants her daughters to succeed so that they can find happiness, but she sometimes conveys it in the wrong way.

[JONATHAN] [GENDER: MALE] [AGE: 21-30]

Reid's ex-fiancé. Incredibly nice and put together. On paper, perfect husband material.
