ESTIMATED POPULATIONS IN CONNECTICUT AS OF JULY 1, 1999

Population estimates for 1999 for Connecticut's eight counties and 169 towns were prepared for distribution by the Connecticut Department of Public Health, Office of Policy, Planning, and Evaluation. The 1999 estimates are consistent with the new estimation method adopted in 1997. (1) These estimates constitute the basis of birth, death, and other population-based rates for 1999 and forward.

Method of Estimation

County and Town Estimates

The U.S. Census Bureau's Population Estimates Program issues total population estimates for Connecticut counties and towns as of July 1 of the prior year. In the past, such estimates were issued only during odd-numbered years, but the year 2000 is an exception. The 1999 estimates were released on October 20, 2000. (2) The U.S. Census Bureau figures are adopted without modification for the state's town-level estimates.

1999 Population Estimates

The 1999 population estimate for the state of Connecticut compared to the 1990 U.S. Census population count is shown below. The 1999 estimate was 7,962 higher than the 1998 estimate of 3,274,069. Population estimates for Connecticut's counties and towns are given in the attached table.
