and

ADVENT CAT RISK, LLC.

Exhibit A to the INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR AGREEMENT dated January 11, 2013 between the Connecticut Health Insurance Exchange, a quasi-public agency created by the State of Connecticut pursuant to Public Act 11-53, with an office at 280 Trumbull Street, Hartford, Connecticut 06103 and Advent Cat Risk, LLC, a Delaware Limited Liability Company with an office at 1 Sedgwick Road, West Hartford, CT 06107 (the "Contractor") is hereby amended:

Services

- Continue Review of Existing Exchange Insurance Coverages: GL, Umbrella, E&O, BOP, WC, EPL, Crime, Property and Cyber Liability policies and develop a cost effective strategy for securing appropriate coverages above that contractually required of the Exchange's subcontracted vendors.
- Introduce the concept of the Exchange and Exchange business to underwriters at lead carriers in the various insurance markets to facilitate Exchange's ability to secure required coverages at competitive rates.
- Assist Exchange Legal in negotiating specific contract provisions including but not limited to endorsement language and any specialty requirements, in the Exchange's insurance contracts.
- Assist Exchange in managing the administrative relationship with the carriers, including applications for coverage; coordination and evaluation of bid proposals, policy placement, and broker management, as well as the addition of additional insured and facilities to Exchange policies on Exchange request and assistance in claims reporting.
- Review all large Exchange subcontracts including but not limited to Maximus, HealthPass, bswift, Pappas Macdonnell, HRA and PAI and access coverage risks for the services provided.
- Recommend to Exchange Legal, the types and levels of coverage, endorsements, and indemnification provisions that should be required in the various subcontracts.
- Participate in contract negotiations with the Exchange's subcontractors on an as requested by Legal basis.

- Advise Exchange Legal on data privacy and security risks and cost effective mitigation strategies.
- Work with Exchange to secure adequate levels of coverages for the Exchange's outreach and education activities including its use of Navigators and In-person Assisters to education and enroll consumers in Exchange offered insurance products under the ACA.
- Provide services to report claims and manage the updates to underwriters and brokers.

Deadlines/Timeline

If not terminated earlier in accordance with the provisions of this Agreement, the term of this Agreement is extended to December 31, 2014.

Compensation

The Exchange shall pay the Contractor on an hourly basis at the rates set forth below for the Services rendered under this Agreement for a sum not to exceed One Hundred and Twenty Five Thousand Dollars (\$125,000.).




