

**EXPAND THE USE OF IGNITION INTERLOCK DEVICES IN
MOTOR VEHICLES**

Senate Bill No. 151

The proposal would allow for the use of ignition interlock devices for all convicted drunk drivers. Statistics have shown that as many as fifty to seventy percent of drunk driving offenders continue to drive while their drivers' licenses are either suspended or revoked. According to a Gallup poll, of the general driving population, ninety-eight percent (98%) perceive drinking and driving as a threat to their personal safety and eighty-six percent (86%) feel it is very important to do something to reduce the problem.

Ignition interlock devices allow society to better hold drunk drivers accountable for their actions and simultaneously ensure that they not be placed in a situation which renders further harm to innocent people. In addition, ignition interlock devices have proven to deter drinking and driving and change behaviors of drunk drivers.
