1. The committee of a candidate on the ballot at the March 2, 2009 election, which reports a deficit on June 8, 2009 will thereafter file on the 7th day of each month following, if on the last day of the preceding month, there was an increase or decrease of more than \$500 from that reported on the last Statement.

Or

2. The committee of a candidate on the ballot at the March 2, 2009 election must distribute or expend any surplus by June 1, 2009 and report such distribution within 7 days thereafter.

Please Note: If any candidate in a special election campaign with at least one participating candidate receives an excess receipt or makes or incurs an expenditure exceeding 90% of the applicable grant for that campaign, *supplemental* campaign finance statement(s) are required.
