BYSIEWICZ REMINDS NAUGATUCK VOTERS TO REGISTER FOR SPECIAL ELECTION IN 70TH ASSEMBLY DISTRICT

SECRETARY OF THE STATE REMINDING VOTERS OF FEBRUARY 27TH DEADLINE
TO REGISTER FOR SPECIAL ELECTION MARCH 2, 2009

HARTFORD: Secretary of the State Susan Bysiewicz today is reminding voters in Naugatuck to register to vote for the Special Election to take place Monday March 2, 2009. Eligible voters who reside in the 70th House district in Naugatuck have one week from today, Friday February 27th at noon, to register to vote at Town Hall for the upcoming Special Election. Voters will go to the polls on Monday March 2nd to choose a successor to former State Representative Kevin DelGobbo, who resigned from office on January 6, 2009. The 70th General Assembly district covers the eastern half of the town of Naugatuck.

“I want to make sure everyone who wants to vote in the upcoming Special Election in Naugatuck is registered by the deadline, which is February 27th at noon,” said Secretary Bysiewicz. “In order to register, eligible voters must fill out a registration card and present the proper form of identification at the Registrar of Voters office in Naugatuck. Absentee ballots for the 70th district special election are available now and will be counted so long as they are turned into the Naugatuck Town Clerk’s office before the close of the polls on March 2nd.”

Polls will open from 6:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. in the 70th House district in Naugatuck on Monday March 2nd for the Special Election.
